ABOUT VOLUNTEER SOCIAL CRIME PREVENTION PROGRAMME

The Volunteer Social Crime Prevention Programme (VSCPP) is run by the Department of Community Safety and Liaison that seeks to:

- Engage communities in social crime prevention
- Encourage communities to fight against crime
- Implement world-class proven social crime reduction methodologies in KwaZulu-Natal
- Replace fear of crime with reassurance amongst communities
- Promote KwaZulu-Natal as a safe place for communities, tourists and businesses

Volunteers will perform defined functions of social crime prevention, distinct from the objective of Community Police Forums and the South African Police Service. The main objectives are to mobilise communities on a day-to-day basis by facilitation of localised social crime priorities, to achieve skills development for unemployed youth and to prioritise community activism against social crime through activities such as:

- Researching and reporting on common social crimes
- Public meetings
- Consultative forums
- Early warning activities
